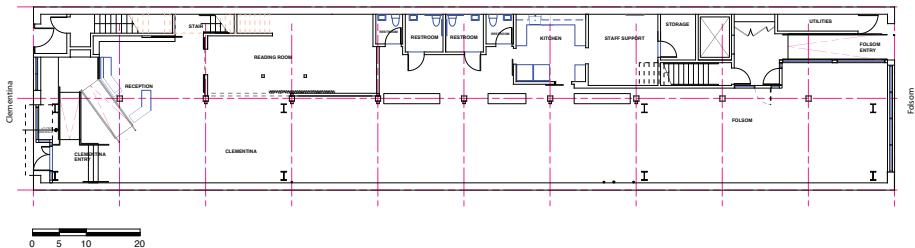
AMERICAN BOOKBINDERS MUSEUM
